

Annual Prescribing Conference 2015 Poster Guidelines

There is still little published to demonstrate the impact and effectiveness of non-medical prescribing, and we would like to start to gather evidence for this.

We shall therefore be having a poster presentation area at the Annual Conference.

Posters on any subject related to non-prescribing are welcome but we are particularly hoping that people will present posters that demonstrate impact and effectiveness.

There will be prizes for the best posters.

Guidelines

The best posters are simple and clear – including too much information makes them hard to read and off putting.

Your medical illustration department will be able to offer guidance on setting up and producing an attractive poster, but there are also numerous guides available on the internet. Good examples include the University of Berkeley (<http://tiny.cc/4mo7tx>) or Napier University (<http://tiny.cc/uoo7tx>), or use Google to find some more.

Think about your prescribing practice and the impact that it has on patient care or service delivery.

If necessary gather some simple data to illustrate the impact.

Prepare a clear and attractive poster; if possible have it printed to A3 size.

If possible be prepared to talk about it to anyone who stops and is interested, and consider whether you want handouts for people to take away.
